
Double-Blind Test of the Effects of Distant Intention on Water Crystal Formation

The hypothesis that water "treated" with intention can affect ice crystals formed from that water was pilot tested under double-blind conditions. A group of approximately 2,000 people in Tokyo focused positive intentions toward water samples located inside an electromagnetically shielded room in California. That group was unaware of similar water samples set aside in a different location as controls. Ice crystals formed from both sets of

water samples were blindly identified and photographed by an analyst, and the resulting images were blindly assessed for aesthetic appeal by 100 independent judges. Results indicated that crystals from the treated water were given higher scores for aesthetic appeal than those from the control water (P = .001, one-tailed), lending support to the hypothesis.

Can the Placebo Be the Cure?

Last winter, psychiatrists and drug company executives were eagerly anticipating the arrival of a new product to fight depression.

January, those hopes were dashed when Merck, in an abrupt reversal, disclosed that MK-869 would be shelved as an antidepressant, although it may find a limited market as a treatment for nausea during chemotherapy. What went wrong?

Merck was struck by "the curse of the placebo effect," some researchery concluded. A Merck press release explained that when the company analyzed data from a new clinical trial in January, it found that putients who had received a dummy pill had done unexpectedly well. They did almost as well, in fact, as those on MK-869, wiping out the rationale for the new drug. The news was a downer for Merck and Wall Street: The price of the company's stock dropped 5% on the day Merck broke the news. It rebounded within the week, however, in part because Merck is already testing a new antidepressant that could be more potent and "much better than MK-869," according to Reynold Spector, executive vice president of Merck Research Laboratories in Rahway, New Jersey (see sidebar).

The MK-869 reversal may have been a temporary sethick for Merck, but it highlights a chaonic problem for psychopharmicology—the placebo effect. It's a phenomenon that bedevils many trials of anti-depressant drugs, spealing some and driving up the cost of others, as clinicians are forced to recruit more patients to obtain statistically significant data. Drug developers regard it as an occupational hazard that masks the effects of potentially useful compounds. But there's more to it than that Some psychia-

Miracle cure

The placebo effect has complicated medical research ever since its miraculous powers were discovered in the 1950s. Administering a simple sugar pill or injecting water, for indepressions, says Dennis Charney, director of the Yale Mental Health Clinical Research Center, it's not uncorramon for 65% of the patients on the new drug to get better. But 35% of the patients in the placebo group also typically improve. Frequently, the differences between the two groups are so small as to be statistically insignificant. "That's probably the most common reason for depression studies to fail," says Thomas Laughren, team leader for the psychiatric drug products group at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Researchers think several different factors play a role in helping some people get better on a dummy pill. Depressions often wax and ware, so improvements observed during a trial may be part of the disease's natural cycle. Simply enrolling in a trial helps some patients, says Charney, no mater what's in the capsales they take home: "You come in, you haven't gotten any help, and [now] you're seeing somebody who cares about you, who is asking about your life. That will improve symptoms."

Trial results may also be blurred because it's difficult to measure depression. When testing the value of, say, a cholesterol-lowering drug, says Spector, scientists can count the deaths in each group at the end: "You don't have to be a rocket scientist to do those trials." But depression is usually measured using the Hamilton scale, which gives patients one to four points on items like mood, guilty feelings, saicidal thoughts, and insomma. Generally, patients are reconfied as "responders" to a drug if the "Hami" score

ABSTRACT

To create an organism, two genetic programs are required. The first one is geometric, i.e. a scheme, how to design the body. The second program is in the form of a meaningful text which contains instructions and explanations how to use the first program, how to understand and build the organism. These programs exist in the form of "DNA video tapes", which are used by the genetic apparatus, acting like a bio-computer. When the bio-computer reads these video tapes, sound and light images appear that constitute the movie program of the development of the organism. When the creation of a grown-up organism is completed, the movie ends. Then the second movie starts, which contains the instructions for maintenance of the organism for indefinitely long time. Unfortunately, the videotapes containing information about a perfectly healthy organism, get corrupted with time, errors accumulate (DNA mutations). The instructions accumulate errors and the organism gets sick, grows old and dies. It is very likely that these DNA video tapes can be renewed and corrected. With this new understanding of how our genetic apparatus works, completely new technologies for healing a person and extending a person's life become feasible. And this is the essence of wave genetics and its practical applications to come.






